The St. Andrew Choristers are the official children's liturgical choir of St. Andrew the Apostle parish. The Choristers minister at the 9:30am Mass on the last Sunday of every month from September through May (except December). The Choristers also minister at Christmas Eve, Easter, and First Communion. We also perform at Celebration in the Oaks and at the Parish Christmas caroling in December.

The Choristers rehearse every Tuesday afternoon from 3:00 to 4:00 on the second floor of the Tower. Membership is open to all parishioners in the 3rd, 4th, or 5th grade, not just St. Andrew the Apostle School students. **Our first rehearsal is Tuesday, September 6th.** Guitarists who played with us last year will practice from 4:00 to 4:30 right after regular practice, starting September 6th. Beginner guitarists will be invited to play in January. If you are interested in being a member, please have your parents fill out the registration form below and bring it to rehearsal, or return it to the St. Andrew School Office or the Rectory.
