# Good Friday Church Walk Pilgrimage with SANYO

SANYO will be participating in the Walk of the Nine Churches – a tradition in the Archdiocese of New Orleans where pilgrims visit multiple churches to pray and reflect upon Christ's passion and death. We will be visiting 6 churches by foot and share a lite lunch together before attending the 3pm Good Friday service at St. Andrew. All family members are welcome to attend! Children who are not members of SANYO must be accompanied by a parent. SANYO/ Jr. SANYO members attending without a parent must have a signed permission slip to participate.

General overview for the day:

- Bring a meatless lunch, water bottle, and rosary (must carry yourself; consider a backpack or pull a wagon). Wear comfortable shoes and clothing.
- Meet in front of St. Stephen at 8:45-9am.
- Once all members/families have arrived we will begin our pilgrimage.
- The distance we will walk is a total of about 3.3 miles. Map and churches on back.
- We plan to eat lunch around noon behind St. Mary's Assumption, in the yard near the National Shrine of Blessed Seelos.
- Members needing a ride home should coordinate with parents to be picked up from St. Mary's Assumption at 12:30pm. Families who drove will coordinate returning to vehicles to pick up families from St. Mary's Assumption. Be prepared to ride the streetcar if needed.
- All are welcome to attend 3pm Good Friday Service at St. Andrew for Prayer, Veneration of the Cross, and Communion. 6pm Stations of the Cross will also take place.
