We are dedicated to the beautification of the sanctuary and to provide and care for the linens, the priest and acolyte vestments, the sacred vessels, and the flowers.

We are nourished spiritually by hosting Days of Reflection; lecturing and distributing Holy Communion at daily mass. The members pray for religious vocations; pray for and visit the sick and shut-ins; say the rosary at the wake when a member or close family member dies; and minister to the needs of the elderly at Jo Ellen Smith Convalescent Center.

Assist or co-ordinate receptions for the priests and other special functions, and solicit donations to the Sanctuary Fund.

Our general meetings are held on the second Thursday of each month with the exception of July.

Our membership dues are \$5.00 annually. The membership year runs from May through April of the following year.
