Step 2	During the week that your family has the May Crowning box, select a day for the Family May Crowning Prayer Service.						
Step 3	Display Our Blessed Mother in a prominent place.						
Step 4	Distribute the Blessed Rosaries and Miraculous Medals to each family member.						
Step 5	Follow the May Crowning Prayer Service for the Home on the date selected.						
Step 6	Record the date of your family's Crowning of Our Blessed Mother and your intentions in the notebook. Return the May Crowning Prayer Service for the Home to the folder.						
Step 7	Pray the rosary with your family often during the week Mother Mary is in your home.						
Step 8	Return the May Crowning box the following week at the same Mass time you received it. Arrive 15 minutes before Mass. A Legion of Mary member will be at the inside front entrance to receive the box so that it can be shared with the next family. If you're unable to return the box, please call Pam Austin at 504-427-2849 to make other arrangements before the following week's Mass.
