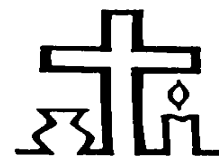

Baptisms are generally held the first Saturday of the month at 9:30AM in Church. The Baptism form is due on or before the 15th of the month prior to the Baptism date.

The following information is needed for your child(ren) to be baptized at St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church:

1. You **must** be a **registered** parishioner of St. Andrew the Apostle Parish. If not, you must register before the application for Baptism can be processed.
2. If there are any questions, call the parish office at 504-393-2334, to speak to the Sacramental Coordinator.
3. If you are **not** married to the father of the child and the father's name is not on the Birth Certificate, a **Letter of Paternity** from an attorney is required if you request that the father's last name is to appear on the Baptismal certificate.
4. You **MUST** complete this form in a NEAT, CLEAR and LEGIBLE manner. If there is a mistake on the Baptism certificate due to the illegible handwriting, the certificate will be replaced at a charge of \$5.00.
5. Baptisms are not recommended by the Church during Lent.
